Health Risk

“something that could cause harm to people's health”



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A risk factor is any attribute, characteristic or exposure of an individual that increases the likelihood of developing a disease or injury (WHO).

Some examples of the more important risk factors are;

Underweight, overweight,

Unsafe sex,

High blood pressure,

Tobacco and alcohol consumption, and

Unsafe water, sanitation and hygiene.

Goal 3 Targets 1/4

- By 2030, reduce the global **maternal mortality** ratio to less than 70 per 100,000 live births
- By 2030, reduce **neonatal mortality** to at least as low as 12 per 1,000 live births and **under-5 mortality** to at least as low as 25 per 1,000 live births
- By 2030, end the epidemics of **AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria** and neglected tropical diseases and combat **hepatitis, water-borne diseases** and other communicable diseases
- By 2030, reduce by one third premature mortality **from non-communicable diseases** through prevention and treatment and promote mental health and well-being

Goal 3 Targets 2/4

- By 2020, halve the number of global deaths and **injuries from road traffic accidents**
- By 2030, ensure universal access to **sexual and reproductive** health-care services, including for **family planning**, information and education
- By 2030, reduce the number of deaths and illnesses from **hazardous chemicals and air, water and soil pollution** and contamination



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Goal 3 Targets (Process) 3/4


- Achieve **universal health coverage**, including financial risk protection, access to quality essential health-care services
- Strengthen the prevention and treatment of **substance abuse**, including narcotic drug abuse and harmful use of alcohol
- Strengthen the implementation of the WHO Framework Convention on **Tobacco Control** in all countries,
- Support the **research and development** of vaccines and medicines for the communicable and non-communicable



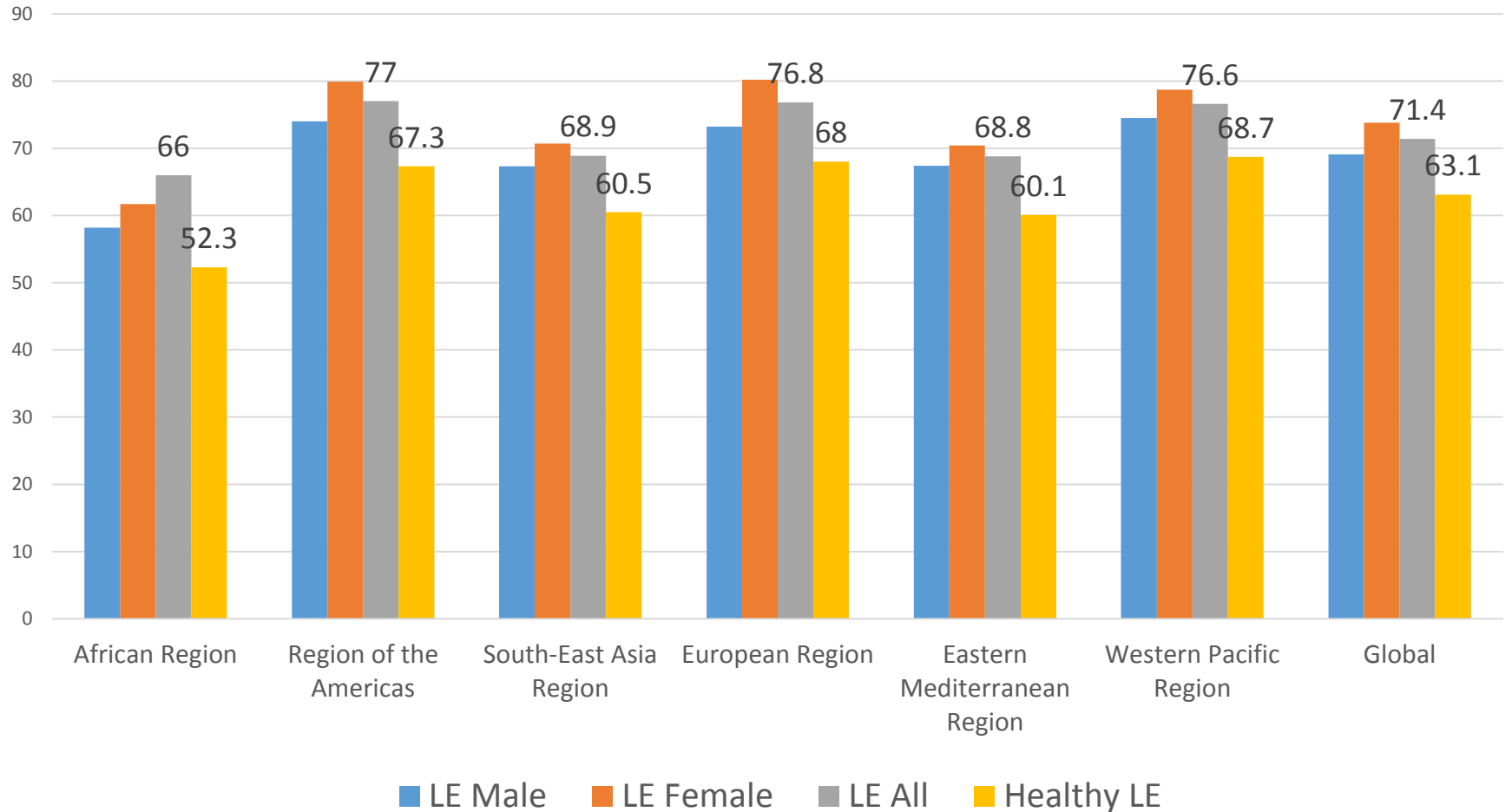
