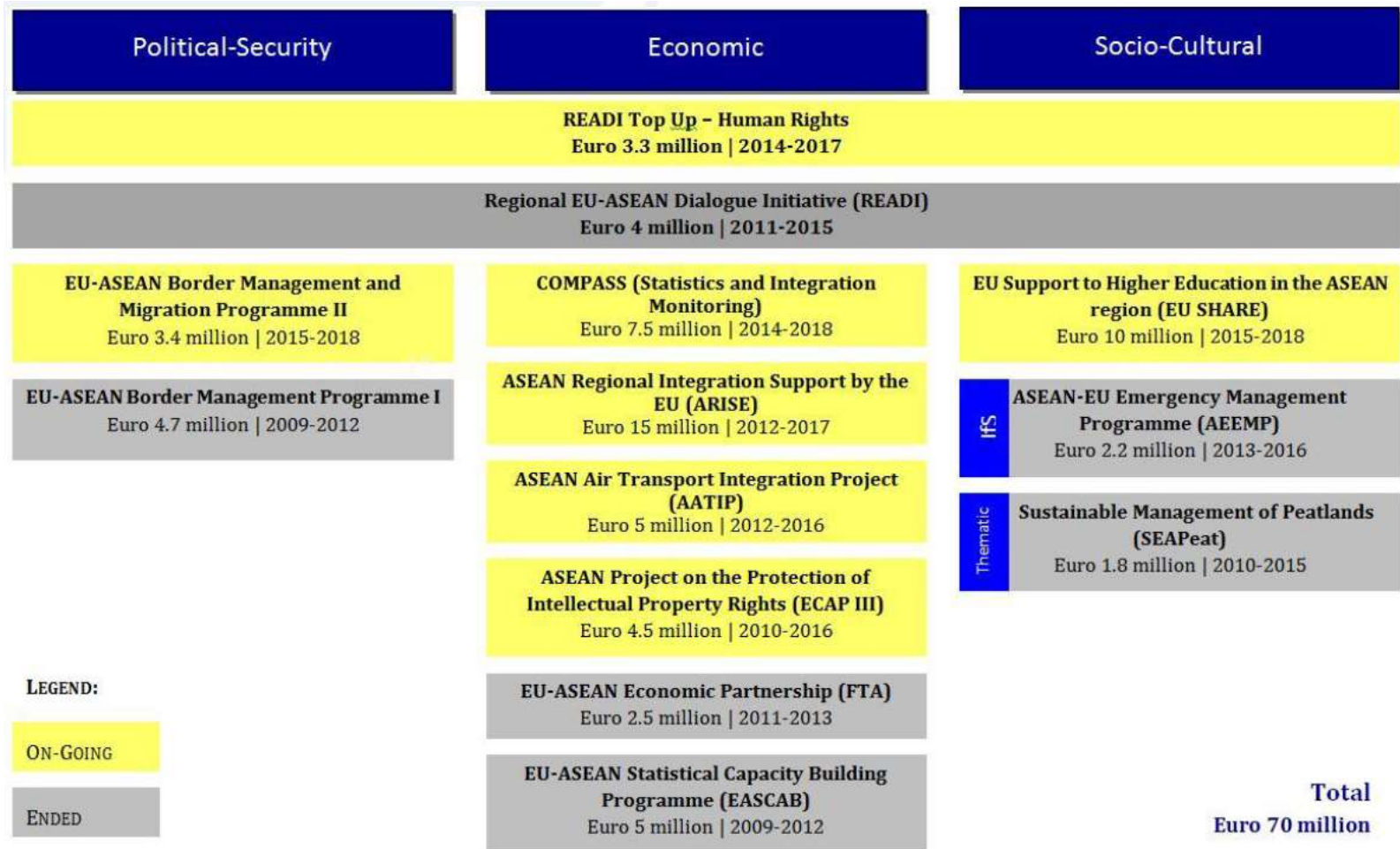

EU Support to Higher Education in the ASEAN Region (**EU-SHARE**)

- Harmonise higher education in ASEAN
- Enhance quality and internationalisation of ASEAN higher education institutions
- **Support mutual recognition and student mobility in ASEAN**, through credit transfer system and pilot scholarships

EUR 10 Million – 2015 to 2019

Implemented by a **consortium of EU higher education institutions** led by **British Council**



3) New EU-ASEAN Programme

- ASEAN Regional Integration Support by the EU (**ARISE+**); €40M (2017-2021)
- Sustainable Use of Peatlands and Haze Mitigation (€20M)
- Enhanced Regional EU-ASEAN Dialogue Instrument (**E-READI**); €20M (2016-2019)

Pipeline:

- Strengthening Disaster Management Capacities in ASEAN (€10M, 2017)
- Support to Environmentally Sustainable, Low Carbon and Climate Resilient ASEAN cities, (€20M, 2018)
- ASEAN Safe Schools & Environmental Education (€10M, 2018)

What does it support? **Grants:** actions and activities in the fields of education, training, youth and sport.

To whom? to students, trainees, staff and volunteers to spend a period abroad to increase their skills and employability.
